Typical use

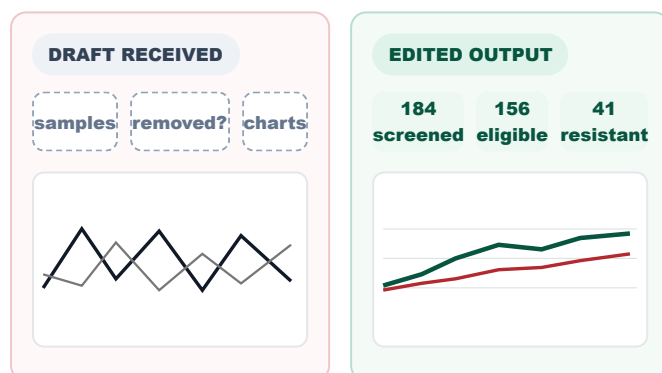
Submission-ready visuals

For journal figures, tables, graphical abstracts, result panels, and production checks.

EXAMPLE PROJECT

Antimicrobial resistance results package

An author submits mixed draft charts, a screening flow, and a rough results table. GAP prepares a cleaner visual set with consistent labels, color contrast, journal-safe fonts, and export-ready files.



WHAT GAP CHECKS

- Target journal figure size, file type, and resolution instructions.
- Panel labels, legends, units, statistical notation, abbreviations, and accessibility.
- Color consistency across related figures and tables.
- Readable typography for print, PDF, and online article pages.
- Clear separation between client-provided data and editorial/design changes.

Client should provide

- Original editable files when available.
- Target journal link or author instructions.
- Preferred colors, labels, and required terminology.
- Any reviewer or editor comments related to visuals.

Visual audit notes and scope confirmation.

Cleaned figures, tables, or chart panels.

Export-ready files for journal upload.

Completion record for final invoice or certificate workflow.

Item	Output	Notes
Figure 1	Flow diagram	Redrawn, relabeled, aligned to journal style.
Figure 2	Seasonal line chart	Color-safe palette, clearer axis titles.
Table 1	Summary results	Units, abbreviations, and footnotes standardized.

Use the Services quote builder and select **Figures & Layout Formatting**. Add figure count, table count, deadline, target journal, and upload notes in the project description.

Good project note example

Six figures, two tables, veterinary journal submission, 7-day deadline, need PNG/TIFF exports and editable source where possible.
